



# Behavior Services

*CNNH Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA) provide home, school, and in-office services for children with developmental disorders, social deficits, and challenging behaviors.*

## → School Supports

A student exhibiting problem behaviors in the classroom requires consideration for “positive behavioral interventions and supports” as part of their Individualized Education Plan (IEP). A CNNH Board Certified Behavior Analyst can directly observe a student in their classroom setting for a **Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA)**. Following the FBA, an individualized **Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP)** can be formulated and monitored to increase functional and developmental goals for the student.

## → Applied Behavior Analysis Therapy (ABA)

ABA therapy is an empirically-based therapy placing emphasis on functional skills that are meaningful in daily life. Reinforcement in structured and natural environments help individuals learn new skills both simple and complex. Skills are taught through discrete trials as well as through functional play and communication, helping to accomplish measurable goals and foster pre-academic/academic skills, social skills, self-care skills, language, and communication. Materials available include icon-based systems, iPad training, activity schedules, and reinforcement systems.

## → Staff and Parent Training

CNNH Board Certified Behavior Analysts are available to train teachers, para-professionals, and families to perform the tasks associated with executing a behavior plan. Hands-on training can be provided within the classroom setting or as part of a teacher in-service.

Training includes:

- Positive Behavior Supports
- Development of Classroom Behavior Management Systems
- Fading supports and decreasing prompt dependency
- Social Skills Groups
- Staff Effectiveness and Safety Techniques
