→ Functional Behavior Assessments (FBA)

A CNNH Behavior Analyst will conduct a direct observation of the student in their immediate setting to develop effective, function-based recommendations.

→ Behavior Intervention Plans (BIP)

Individualized behavior plans may be necessary in effectively increasing functional and developmentally appropriate goals for the student. A CNNH Behavior Analyst can create a plan and analyze data to ensure the plan's efficacy and to provide modifications.

→ Staff Training

CNNH Behavior Analysts are available to train teachers, para-professionals, and families to perform the tasks associated with executing a behavior plan. Hands-on training can be provided within the classroom setting or as part of a teacher in-service.

- Development of Classroom Behavior Management Systems
- Fading supports and decreasing prompt dependency
- Social Skills Groups
- Staff Effectiveness and Safety Techniques

→ Neuropsychological and Psychoeducational Evaluations

A CNNH Neuropsychologist can evaluate a student for cognitive strengths and weaknesses, review IEP's, and recommend Curriculum Planning.

→ Additional Services

Neurological Evaluations - A CNNH Neurologist can administer a comprehensive exam, provide ongoing medication management and mental health supports.

Autism Diagnoses - The Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS) is the gold standard, measuring communication, social interaction, play, and imagination.

ADHD Testing - The Quotient ADHD System® is an objective computerized test measuring inattention, hyperactivity, and impulsivity for accurate diagnoses and treatment.

Sports Concussion Management - Comprehensive concussion evaluations and recovery plans utilizing the ImpACT™ computerized concussion assessment.

Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) - Helps students change their thoughts and behaviors.
